City and nature echo one another without ever competing, creating a direct, generous energy that is deeply rooted.

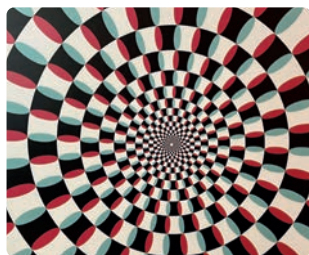

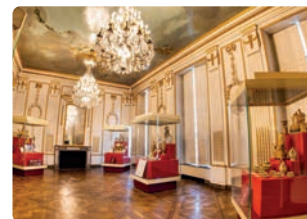
GRAND CURTIUS



Facing the Meuse, the Grand Curtius brings together more than 7,000 years of art and history in a complex of 16th- to 18th-century palaces. Behind the red brick and Meuse stone facades unfold five major collections: archaeology, weapons, religious and Mosan art, decorative arts and glass. From prehistoric bifaces to refined clocks, from stained glass to Liège weapons, each room reveals craftsmen's expertise and the wealth of the Principality of Liège. An unmissable museum to understand the soul of the city and admire exceptional pieces in a remarkable heritage setting.

LA BOVERIE



In the heart of a listed park, nestled in a Meuse meander, La Boverie combines Belle Epoque elegance and contemporary architecture. The 1905 Palace of Fine Arts, extended by a glass wing by Rudy Ricciotti, houses the collections of the Liège Museum of Fine Arts: from the Renaissance to modern art, with Ingres, Monet, Gauguin, Chagall, Picasso, Ensor, Magritte... The accessible and didactic route is complemented by major temporary exhibitions. A light-filled and inspiring place where you cross five centuries of creation in a green setting by the water.






In a house scented with wood and stone, follow the history of the Ourthe-Amblève, from Prehistory to our grandparents. Objects and stories link memory and landscape.

Located next to the famous American memorial at Mardasson, this museum offers an immersive journey through the Second World War and the Battle of the Bulge, accessible to the whole family. HAN CAVES DOMAIN - HAN CAVES



In the heart of a UNESCO-recognised Geopark, this cave reveals 1.3 km of underground wonders. Varied formations, galleries sculpted by the Lesse and reflections on the water all culminate in the Dome Hall, 145 metres high. Along the way, the 'Origin' show envelops visitors with 360° sound and light, enhancing the relief with discreet LED lighting. The 'Drapery Hall' seems to be draped in stone fabrics, while the exit is via large walkways suspended over the river. A guided exploration, rated three stars in the Green Guide, that leaves the impression of a journey to the centre of the Earth.

HAN CAVES DOMAIN - WILDLIFE PARK



Across 250 hectares of forests, meadows and hills, this wildlife park offers a big breath of nature. On foot or by safari vehicle, you encounter deer, fallow deer, wild boars, lynx, wolves, wolverines and European bison, not forgetting the Przewalski's horse. Stunning panoramas reveal the ancient Lesse valley and the mysterious Gouffre de Belvaux. The visit ends at Bear Hill, two hectares where three brown bears play, forage and swim under families' amazed eyes. A true sanctuary of biodiversity, the site participates in protection and reintroduction programmes for endangered species, giving the walk both an emotional and educational dimension.

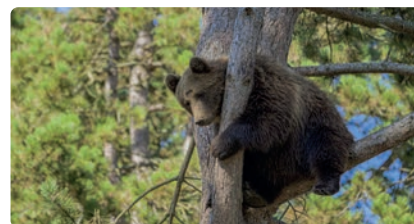

TRAVELLING WITH YOUR FAMILY?

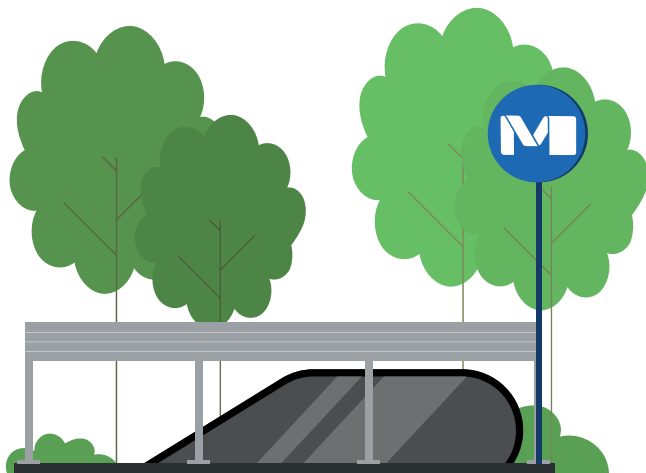
Children under 6 years old use STIB-MIVB **for free**. Simply use the special entry gates for families to access the metro station platforms.

If you pay contactless, you'll need **one device** (bank card, smartphone or smartwatch) **per person**. You can also buy 1-journey or 1-day paper tickets at the **vending machines** located at the stops and in the stations or even at the **KIOSK and BOOTIK sales outlets** in the main metro stations.

WHERE CAN YOU BUY TICKETS?

The easiest way is to **pay contactless** directly in the stations or in the vehicles. Simply tap your **bank card** (or smartphone) on the grey validating machines, and **it becomes your ticket!**

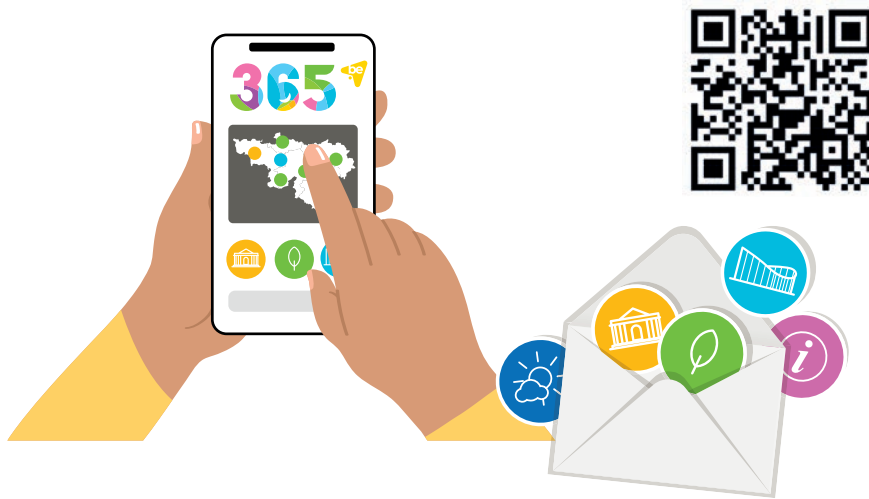
