A fabulous collection of over sixty vehicles (trams, trolleybuses, buses and taxis) that have travelled around Brussels from 1869 to current day, set in a fully-refurbished museum depot.

You can hop on an ancient tram for a ride from the Tram Museum to Tervueren through Soignes Forest (1 hr return trip), or to the Cinquantenaire site.

Museum buses also run from the Tram Museum to the Cinquantenaire site.
