By car: Esplanade parking via Drève Anna Boch or Parklane parking via 13 Rue Picard.

By public transport: bus 57, 86 et 88 Tour & Taxis stop (the closest), bus 14 et 20 Suzan Daniel stop.

Metros: line 2 and 6. Yser, Ribaucourt and Pannenhuis stops are a 10-minute walk away.

Train: 15 minutes by foot from the North Station (Gare du Nord).
