### Famenne & Art Museum, a promise of an intimate artistic discovery

The **Famenne & Art Museum** surprises visitors with its dual identity. **Two museums, two atmospheres**, brought together in a single place to explore both the cultural richness of the **Famenne** and the world of the Belgian painter **Remy Van den Abeele**. Here, the visit unfolds in a **warm and family-friendly** atmosphere, far from rigid conventions, within a heritage setting that invites both curiosity and the pleasure of wandering.

From the moment you arrive, the welcome is simple and warm. The museum immediately sets the tone: accessible, human and designed so that everyone can find their place, regardless of age or familiarity with art.

### A listed building that already tells a story

The visit begins in a **listed building**, whose charm is immediately apparent. The **fireplaces, mouldings, marble floors** and **authentic tapestries** create an elegant and intimate atmosphere. Each room seems to carry the memory of the place, offering a refined setting that never feels intimidating.

The light, the volumes and the architectural details accompany the visit and reinforce the pleasant feeling of entering a house inhabited by art and history. Visitors naturally take time to observe their surroundings as much as the artworks themselves.

### Two routes, two complementary perspectives

The richness of the Famenne & Art Museum lies in its **contrasting discovery route**. On one side, the section dedicated to the **Famenne** highlights the identity, heritage and distinctive features of this territory. The approach is clear and accessible, helping visitors better understand the soul of the region through objects, stories and carefully presented interpretations.

On the other side, the space devoted to **Remy Van den Abeele** immerses visitors in the **virtuosity of a Belgian artist**, offering a sensitive and in-depth reading of his work. The contrast between the two universes enriches the visit: from a territorial discovery to a more intimate artistic immersion, without abrupt transitions, in a fluid and coherent dialogue.

### Temporary exhibitions that spark curiosity

A dedicated space hosts **temporary exhibitions**, renewed **twice a year**. These exhibitions highlight emerging artists chosen as favourites by the curator, or bring renewed attention to **historical artists sometimes forgotten**. The museum enjoys **focusing on little-known or unexpected elements**, offering fresh perspectives and inspiring surprise.

This dynamic programme encourages visitors to return. Each visit can be different, shaped by this desire to discover, question and share unique perspectives on art.

## A museum designed for families and shared experiences

The Famenne & Art Museum pays particular attention to **families**. **Playful discovery routes**, activities and adapted installations are regularly offered to provide a **fresh and engaging museum experience**. Here, children are not simply spectators: they play, search and interact, while adults rediscover the collections through a lighter and more participatory perspective.

This approach encourages **intergenerational sharing**, turning the visit into a moment of connection and making art feel closer and more alive.
